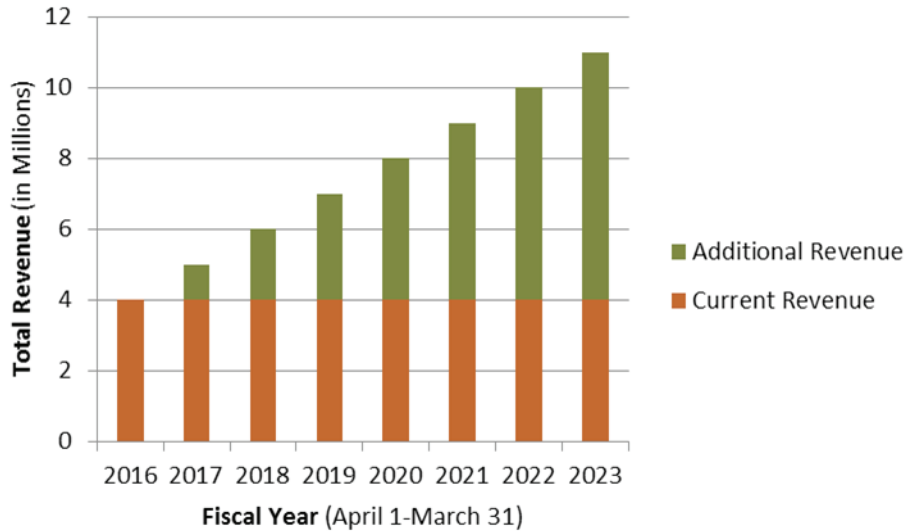

Reaching the Next 1 Million
Growing Lasting Solutions to Hunger

In FRB’s first 15 years we reached over 1 million people in growing lasting solutions to hunger. By 2023 FRB plans to reach the next 1 million people through our sustainable food security programs. Building off of our experience from our first 15 years, FRB will continue impacting lives through agricultural development, community ownership and grassroots voluntarism.



Increase Total Revenue-

Over the next 7 years FRB will raise a total of \$55 million as it will cost on average \$55 per program participant. That means FRB will have to raise an additional \$26-28 million to grow from a \$4 to \$11 million a year organization.

Increase Growing Projects -

We will develop approximately 125 new growing projects in addition to the 200 growing projects we currently have.

Increase Overseas Programs-

FRB will grow its overseas programs from 50-60 program to 210-220 total programs by 2023.

Field Volunteers -

FRB’s Field Volunteers and other key volunteers will play an important roll in maintaining and developing growing projects and relationships with corporations and foundations.

New FRB Staff -

FRB will double its staff from 9 to 18.
